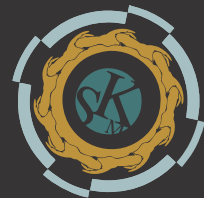

Sedibelo Kgabo Mining (SKM) is a 100% black-owned mining services company offering opencast production hole drilling and blasting services to the mining industry.

Founded by Tshiamo and Kgolagano "Khuli" Matshego in February 2021, SKM has revolutionised South Africa's mining industry since being awarded a production drilling contract for the East Pit of Pilanesberg Platinum Mines (PPM) in the Bushveld Complex, 207km west of Johannesburg, in June 2021.

In less than two years, SKM metamorphosed from 0 to 500 000 progressive production blast hole metres drilled to become the leading drilling service provider at Pilanesberg Platinum Mine (PPM) by modernising production drilling using technology, real-time production monitoring and safe operation.

In so doing, SKM created over 100 sustainable jobs, 75% of which is drawn from the local community and 25% of whom are female employees.

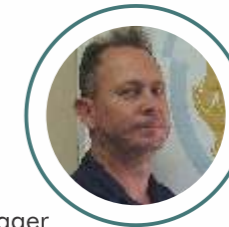

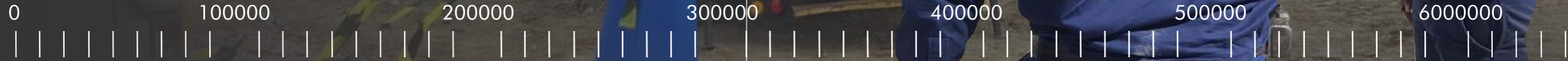
